

Activity Report of India Evangelistic Association Assessment Year - 2022-23, 2023-24, 2024-25

Sustainable Development Program:

The Sustainable Development Center of India Evangelistic Association is located at Mahasingh Mouza, PO- Balliguda, Block-K. Nuagaon, District- Kandhamal. This Center is built on an area of sprawling 1.5 acres land. The Center was specifically meant for the Residential Skills Training and Placement Program to cater the



needs of the unemployed youth (underprivileged, marginalized and downtrodden youth living under the Below Poverty Line belonging to the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes, Minorities and Poor Youth Girls and Boys) so that they will be brought to the ambits of development and sustain their livelihood through Training under Skills and Placement thereafter in various sector skills council. Sustainable

Development Project mediated to bring various Partners and Project Implementing Agencies of the Government to implement such development programs. Around 700 students have been trained in Sectors like Retail, Business Process Outsourcing, Plumbing, Mobile Repairing, Solar Panel and Others. IEA has been able to facilitate the smooth running of Programs by providing its State of the Infrastructure Facilities, Food, Accommodation, Training Infrastructure and being able to Mobilize eligible candidates for the Programs. Sustainable Development Project in its utmost capacity has been able to Empower the Lives of the vulnerable youths and fostering dignity of living among the youths' boys and girls of Kandhamal District. Many students have been placed in different Metropolitan Cities like Bangalore and living an economically established flourished life. They have been able to support their families and meet their emerging needs of the family.



Hope Project:

The objective of Hope Project is to empower the economically backward women of Bidanasi locality near Cuttack city. Gouda (Shepard community) is the original inhabitants of Bidanasi. We have conducted several awareness meetings on health and education



where importance of education and health are taught. About twenty SHG (Self Help Group) have been formed with ten women in each group. Each group has been given a capital fund of Rs.

Rs.30,000.00 (Rupees Thirty thousand only) to start a micro business of their interest. They started doing different

micro business that included making local sandwich items, tailoring, small cloth business etc. They are happy that they could be helped in this manner to help themselves.



BOYS' HOME/HOSTEL:



A Boys Home /hostel is being managed for boys from ST/SC and economically poor background. Also, boys who have lost either father or mother. They hail from economically poor background. Due to the poor condition of the parents, they are unable to meet the educational needs of the children. All the boys are provided free accommodation, food, admission fees, books, uniforms etc. Now we have both school and college boys. College education has become extremely costly. However, several boys have passed out after completion of graduation and are

employed in different sectors. They have stood on their feet and helping their parents. Education is so important for children which is their birth right but many children are deprived of this privilege.. It is not only a issue in the remote villages but equally true in city slums. This has to be addressed in order to empower our community.

LEDERSHIP DEVELOPMENT SEMINARS:

Leadership Development Seminars have been organized at K. Nuagaon (Kandhamal), G. Udayagiri and Puri. After graduation young people seek job and get employed in various sectors both in government and private sectors.



But many young people don't possess that confidence as they move forward. In their respective field how, they should develop leadership which will motivate them to take up leadership position. So, topics like What is Leadership? How to develop leadership in their own field of work? Leadership and responsibility? Leadership and time management?

WIDOWS' HELP:



We have been helping widows who have lost their husbands during Covid.

Some of their children are studying in schools and colleges. These families are most needy. And whatever help little help we have been extending is a drop in the bucket. But we are glad that we have been a blessing to these needy families in this manner.



Educational assistance:

We have been financially assisting 25 needy students towards their education while they are living with their parents in their respective homes. We are sending Rs.2500.00 (Rupees Two thousand five hundred only) through bank transfer every month depending the availability of funds.

Covid Relief:



During Covid we have done lot of relief work in the slums of Cuttack city. Due to shut down people were unable to go for work and were in a miserable



condition. We could reach out to Bidanasi, Birenmitra Park Basti with our relief materials. We were happy to reach out to Leprosy Colony where nearly 3000s-4000 people live with relief Sarees along with rice and cooking items were provided to several families there.

Kaushal Project:

Students at the Kaushal Training Centre enthusiastically learning and growing together through the on-the-job training program. We are delighted to share that their dedication and passion are truly commendable.



Achievements: Students underwent in LED light manufacturing. Eight students completed the training received a manufacturing unit was set up for them at the Kaushal Training Centre. Four students produced 200 LED bulbs and 100 concealed lights in the just five

days . This hands-on project was incredibly exciting the students. They also began marketing small profits to support their education. Though they initially struggled, they are learning direct marketing with determination.

All students are also eager to learn digital marketing and graphic designing to earn while studying through freelancing platforms. One of the trainers who has started a small company.

During their short visit to their respective homes, they welcomed by their parents. Their families were overjoyed to see them. Happy to note that each student 10 LED bulbs they ahd manufacture by themselves. Students also assisted their families by cooking meals, spending quality time with their parents and helping with household responsibilities.
